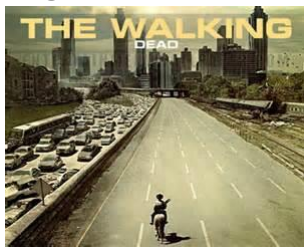


# PEEL 4X4 CLUB QUIZ NIGHT – PUMPHREYS BRIDGE

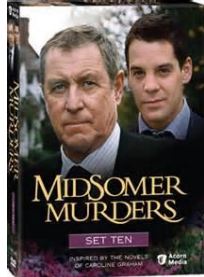
3 May 2014

**Other stuff**

This is a fairly simple overnighter.

Trip rating = easy = social\*.

You will need sufficient fuel to get to Pumphreys Bridge and back again, an evening meal and a brekkie and whatever else you may need to get you through a quiz night and a campfire.

\*If you decide to make it a 4WD driving weekend you need to make sure you have everything with you as per normal 4WD playing. Also factor in that the trip rating may be different depending on where you go (or are taken).

Meals are your responsibility – if you want to cook on Saturday night allow for the start time. Sunday will be whatever you wish to do.

The weather is likely to be cold – hot – wet – dry – windy – calm or a combination of all of these.

You will need to bring a contribution of wood for the campfire.

**Accom.**

The area is big enough for swags, tents, camper trailers, caravans, 5<sup>th</sup> wheelers and cruise ships. There are toilets available but no showers.

The hall will be opened at 4.00pm Saturday.

The hall will be locked at 10am Sunday.

**More other stuff**

Each club is to provide a \$50 food hamper for prizes. 1<sup>st</sup> prize 2 hampers. There will also be other prizes for other things.

Visitors are to supply a bottle of wine each to also be used as prizes.

There will also be raffles run during the night with some pretty good prizes on offer so make sure you have some coin type cash.

Now for the best bit – following on from the last quiz night when the theme was 4WD stuff and Aussie geography, the questions for this quiz night will be themed around MUSIC, TV & MOVIES - so what type of questions can you expect.....a very varied and unusual mix and given the varied types of music I listen to and the shows I watch on TV there may be some surprises.

70% of the questions will be Aussie based and for something a bit different they will be grouped in decades - 50's, 60's, 70's etc. Whatever is left over will be a mix of stuff.
