

Beverley Farm Weekend

What to bring: Camping gear, food drink, drinking water, etc., work clothes, gloves, sturdy footwear. (For those who wish to do a bit of work.

On this weekend we will be planting sandalwood seeds (nuts) to the host trees. Susan and I will have collected the nut harvest over the 2015/16 summer and will have sorted out the best nuts for planting.

The nuts are easy to plant, the soil near the host trees is gouged to about 2cm, the nut dropped in and covered over.

Depending on the weather and whether we have had any rain or not, camp and cooking fires may or may not be allowed.

Please note that the adjoining properties are working farms stocked with sheep and horses. If you must bring your dog it is your responsibility to keep it under full control. If it wanders onto an adjoining property it could be shot on site. You will also need to pick up/bury its droppings.

Toilet and shower facilities are available at the house.
