

## **CHALLENGE IN ISOLATION (google it!)**

## 23rd September to 1 October 2017

(1st week of the school holidays - 25th September is a Public Holiday)

The old telegraph track from Norseman to Baladonia, the Baladonia Track to Israelite Bay via Mt Ragged (climb optional), from Israelite Bay north along the old Telegraph Track to Bilbunya Dunes, up the Wylie Scarp, then north towards Eyre Hwy, back towards Perth from there.

Be fully self-sufficient for 6 days& ~750 km's, small camper trailers ok.

Expect 2200 Km's in total.

**When** 8:00 am, Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2017

**Bring**: Small camper trailers are ok. Please be fully self-sufficient with fuel, water, food, first aid,

medicine & spare parts etc. for around 750 Km& 6 days.

**Level:** TBC, but probably somewhere between lots of fun& very interesting  $\oslash$ 

**Cost:** Fuel, food, maintenance, FINES! ...etc.

**What to expect**: Expect the unexpected as nothing ever goes completely to plan  $\mathfrak{O}!$ 

There are quite a few old& nicely restored homesteads to visit along the old Baladonia track. At Israelite Bay we'll visit the old Telegraph Station and Point Malcolm, around 30 km south of the bay. From there north towards Bilbunya Dunes, the biggest moving sand dunes in the southern hemisphere (so I'm told ©)

Next up the Wylie scarp and north towards Eyre Hwy which brings us back towards Norseman and beyond depending on time & situation. I'd suggest to leave camp in the morning around 0800 so we can find camp around 1600.
