Camps will be decided as we go. Being the Easter long weekend I expect the Track to be busy so to make it easier, I'd like to cap it at 10 vehicles max. I'd recommend camper trailers only as I have only done The Track in bits & pieces so not sure on the entire accessibility for bigger rigs. Once on the south coast I'd like to pay a visit to West Cape Howe & maybe camp one night around Torbay Inlet. West Cape Howe is not suitable for trailers so I'd suggest to leave the trailers either at Torbay Inlet or Shelley beach camp site which is supervised by a care taker.*
